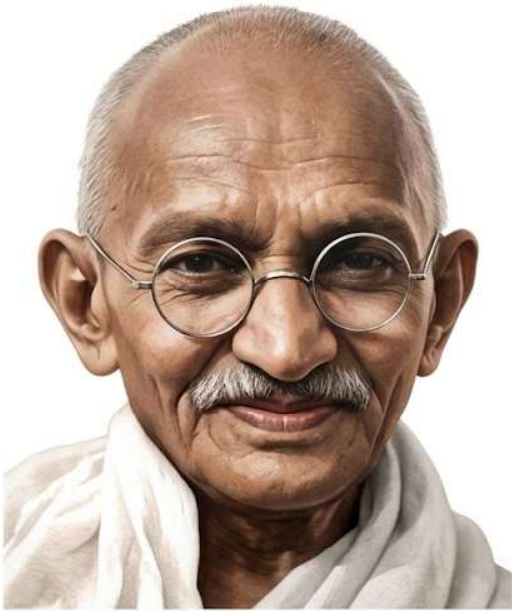


Who Am I?
